What Will I Study?

In this unit, you will develop an initial idea into a 2D or 3D game. You will create visuals to show what the game will look like, as well as a design specification that documents all aspects of the game.

You will then create the assets for the game engine and add interaction to make a playable game. This unit also allows learners to obtain feedback on your work for review and further development.
